

the year. Fishing and snowmobiling are available in the winter, while the spring and fall bring a beautiful view of the migrating waterfowl. Summertime offers an array of activities such as fishing, boating, camping, swimming, and picnicking.

Lake Ashtabula has three designated swimming areas, several lake-front dining options, and seven boat launching ramps maintained to provide boaters and fishermen access to all areas of the lake. All campsites have access to clean drinking water, restrooms, and most are equipped with playgrounds and picnic facilities. The Corps of Engineers operate seven recreation areas around Lake Ashtabula, providing a variety of facilities and services. They also actively manage 14 separate wildlife areas on the lake which provide quality habitat for many wildlife species. The North Country Trail also runs along the lake for those looking for a hiking adventure.

Valley City is one of the best places to fish in the state. With an abundance of large and small lakes and the winding river, you can find the perfect fishing spot. Lake Ashtabula, 12 miles north of Valley City, is a 5,100 acre lake abundant wiith walleye, northern pike, small mouth bass, white bass, yellow perch, and crappie. This fishing gold mine features fishing/ice fishing tournaments throughout the year including the Walleye Durby in June. The Sheyenne River also boasts great fising including catfish, walleye, small-mouth bass, and the occasional muskie. Other locations for great summer fishing include Moon Lake, Fox Lake, and Monson Slough. Looking for an ideal ice fishing spot? Check out Island Lake, Eckelson Lake, Key Lake, and Hobart Lake.

For the Outdoor Enthusiasts

STARGAZING

The outskirts of Valley City are the perfect place to catch the constellations and even the Northern Lights. Find a place in the countryside with little light pollution to see an even more vibrant show of stars!

SNOWMOBILING

The Sheyenne Valley Trail is located south of Valley City. There is a wide variety of riding including a trail that follows the Sheyenne River bottom and the James River. It also has ditch riding, shelter belts, and wide open fields. This takes you through the Fort Ransom State Park and Little Yellowstone. Several other stops are located along the way for you to warm up or relax as you enjoy North Dakota's longest snowmobile trail.

CROSS COUNTRY SKIING

Enjoy a day cross-country skiing on groomed trails at Eggerts Landing north of Valley City and Chautauqua Park (weather permitting).

KAYAKING

Take a trip down the Sheyenne River! Bring your own or rent 1 of 8 rental kayaks through Valley City Parks and Recreation's kayak kiosk located at Bjornson Park Municipal Golf Course. The beautiful Sheyenne River is in the process of becoming a National Water Trail with 199 miles of scenic river bends and endless possibilities to explore!

BIKING

Valley City Parks and Recreation has a bike rental kiosk at the Gaukler Family Wellness Center for visitors to explore Valley City and its abundance of shops, parks, bike paths, and more. Cycle through the heart of Valley City on Central or up to Medicine Wheel Park to see one of the country's only Native American solar calendars and walk through the Solar System. With the convenient size of the town, everything is accessible on a bike! See vcparks.com for more details.

Valley City is lucky to have not only a scenic byway and a water trail, but also the North Country Trail! Listed as the longest route in the National Trails System, the North Country Trail stretches from North Dakota to Vermont through national forests, rolling hills, charming communities, wide open prairies, and more. The NCT also cuts right through Medicine Wheel Park and Central Avenue making Valley City a central location for this activity! Hike this trail to see the beauty of the Valley City area, including the Hi-Line Bridge. Look for the small blue markings!

This Scenic Byway features 40 interpretive sites that give background on this area's settlers and rich history throughout the years. Take in the breathtaking scenes of the Byway as well as the towns along the way.

SCENIC BYWAY


The Sheyenne River Valley
National Scenic Byway stretches
63 miles along the breathtaking
Sheyenne River Valley, from
Baldhill Dam to Lisbon, following
ancient Native American foot
paths and pioneer wagon trails.

Tree-lined, rolling hills are dotted by quaint towns and farmsteads, lending to its Americana charm. In addition to nature and scenery at its best, archaeology, history, culture, and recreation are all found along this byway - North Dakota's first nationally recognized scenic byway.

Along the way you will find Little Yellowstone Park, two log cabins, 40 award winning interpretive and 6 dams.

Midwest Living magazine suggests this roadway as a "Fall Color Drive" and the route was also listed in National Geographic's Guide to Scenic Highways and Byways.

THE NORTH COUNTRY TRAIL

The North Country Trail (NCT) is the longest National Scenic Trail in the national trails system. With over 4,800 miles through different landscapes including grasslands, farms, forests, and communities, the trail runs through eight states including Vermont, New York, Pennsylvania, Ohio, Michigan, Wisconsin, Minnesota, and North Dakota. The NCT runs right through the heart of Valley City and goes north to Lake Ashtabula and south to Kathryn.

See stunning sights along the way including a variety of flora and fauna, the winding Sheyenne River and its scenic landscape, even hiking right under the Hi-Line Bridge which is sure to take your breath away. The beauty along the North Country Trail within the Sheyenne River Valley truly is unmatched.

SHEYENNE RIVER WATER TRAIL

The Sheyenne River Water Trail offers a unique recreational opportunity and enhanced recreation access that helps visitors see more of the area while staying active. Spanning more than 199 river miles, the water trail gives paddlers of all skill levels the opportunity to see the beauty the Sheyenne River has to offer. Float down the winding bends of the Sheyenne River through Valley City, Fort Ransom, and Lisbon, and enjoy both primitive and established launch points. The Water Trail is still being developed with signage, landings, and facilities.

Don't miss out on the biggest water event happening right in Valley City - Sheyenne RiverFest - August 3rd, 2024! Join over 200 other paddlers on the Sheyenne River with a starting launch at the National Fish Hatchery and ending at Chautauqua Park with a craft and vendor show, food trucks, and games!





Chautauqua Park is a Valley City staple - with stunning views of the Hi-Line bridge, a large park, three sand volleyball courts, a dog park, cornhole boards, pinic shelters, a boat and fishing dock, and the Dacotah Pavilion.



Valley City has many parks and playgrounds for all ages to enjoy! Take a splash in the community outdoor pool or let your dog run free at the dog park located in Chautauqua Park! Between all the parks, you can find 9-hole disc golf (City Park), sand volleyball courts (Chautauqua Park), musical performances (City Park and Pioneer Park), and so much more. 

Valley City State University

Valley City State University has been named one of the top public regional colleges in the Midwest and one of America's "Best Colleges" for 26 consecutive years by U.S. News. Founded in 1890, VCSU offers more than 65 undergraduate programs including outstanding reputations in education, business, and more.

Valley City State's 55-acre campus is bordered on the south by a forested hillside and on the north by the Sheyenne River. The campus architecture marries historic and modern buildings to create the perfect place to take a walk, have a picnic, or just drive by! The central campus is listed on the National Register of Historic Places as a Historic District, cementing VCSU's place in North Dakota history. Buzzfeed named VCSU's campus the most beautiful campus in North Dakota in 2017.

Valley City State University is home to the VCSU Vikings. Catch a football, volleyball, baseball, or basketball game or see a band or choir concert in the new Center for the Arts building. VCSU also hosts numerous fun and exciting events throughout the year.

Medicine Wheel Park

This unique 30-acre park on the campus of Valley City State University began as a student project which soon expanded beyond the classroom walls to involve the community to become a major tourist attraction and recreational site for the area with picnic areas and beautiful flowers and plants.

Medicine Wheel

A large circle measuring 213 feet around; the 28 spokes represent the number of days in the lunar cycle. Six spokes extending beyond the Wheel are aligned to the horizon positions of sunrises and sunsets on the first days of the four seasons.


IN THE PARK:

Walking Tour of the Solar System

The model of the solar system is represented with different sized boulders placed in proportion to the planets' average distances from the sun. 1 ft = 3 million miles

Jamestown, ND

Visit our wonderful neighbors to the West! Jamestown has tons of great places to eat, play, and stay on your trip around North Dakota!

World's Largest Buffalo

Standing at 26 feet tall and weighing 60 tons, the World's Largest Buffalo Monument is one of the Midwest's most popular roadside attractions. See live buffalo and visit the Frontier Village to uncover the secrets and rich history of the Jamestown area. Built in 1959, this monument has caught the eye of travelers as it can be seen from I-94. The Buffalo's name christened in 2010, is Dakota Thunder, picked from a contest held the same year. Fun fact - Dakota Thunder weighs about as much as five average-sized African Elephants, or 30 average-sized automobiles!

Kite Fest

Contests for the kids, kite making, concessions, inflatable air games, demonstrations, door prizes, and music fill the weekend. The festival takes place at Meidinger Park Field (10th St. & 17th Ave. SW).

Biking and Hiking Trails

With over 25 miles of trails to explore, Jamestown is one of the best places for hiking and bikings - and we're positive your K9 companions will love it! Traverse scenic views and varied terrain on paved, unpaved, short, long, easy, or challenging trails. For simple easy walks, many parks within Jamestown feature walking trails as well.

Birding

Jamestown and the surrounding areas feature 300+ species of birds to view right in the middle of the Central Flyway and the Prairie Potholes Region. Take the driving trails and see a handful of these birds including the Ferruginous Hawk, Sprague's Pipit, and Gray Partridge.

Hungry Pelican Lake Ashtabula

At not one, but two locations on Lake Ashtabula (the Dam and the Crossing), the Hungry Pelican is your ultimate destination for lake fun. From boat, kayak, paddleboard, and canoe rentals to delicious treats and drinks (including the signature "pelican poop" adult beverage), it's the perfect spot to soak up the weather all year. Keep an eye out for their thrilling events, featuring live bands, artists, volleyball tournaments, and much more!

Oscar-Zero Missile Alert Facility Cooperstown, ND

This preserved Minuteman III Missile Alert Facility located in Cooperstown, ND, was activated in 1966 during the Cold War and staffed 24 hours a day until 1996. The site features the above ground blast doors, a missile silo, the original control room, and more. The site has been transfered to the State Historical Society of North Dakota and is open to the public for individual and group tours where you can visit the facility as it would've looked back then as well as travel into the underground launch control center! For any level of history buff - this is a must see!

Thrill Hills Fort Ransom, ND

Thrill Hills is a snow tubing facility that is fun for the whole family. With concessions and a liquor license, you can get a bite to eat, a drink, and spend the day tubing down the old "bunny hill" at the ski resort. With the new addition of skiing and snowboarding, Thrill Hills is a destination that you have to see. Fort Ransom State Park Fort Ransom, ND

Taking its name from a 1860s military fort, Fort Ransom State Park is located in the midst of the scenic and heavily wooded Sheyenne River Valley. The river provides abundant opportunities for canoeing, fishing and bird watching, while within the park can be found a short segment of the North Country National Scenic Trail. During the summer, horseback riding and camping are favorite activities, while cross-country skiing is a popular winter sport. A farmstead within the park is the setting for the annual Sodbuster Days celebration with demonstrations and exhibits of homesteading life. Fort Ransom State Park offers many amenities and activities for everyone. Featuring a campground and tenting, Fort Ransom State Park also has luxurious yurts that are available for rent with running water, electricity, and a full kitchen.

Little Yellowstone Kathryn, ND

Little Yellowstone Park is a 27 acre campground and recreational area. As a rest stop along the Sheyenne River Valley National Scenic Byway, this recreational area offers stunning hiking along a small stream and is the perfect destination for any outdoor enthusiast. Plan a weekend getaway by staying at the campground or just stop for a hike and a picnic for the day. Little Yellowstone is the picturesque location you've been looking for.

Sodbuster Days Fort Ransom, ND

Sodbuster Days is held each year at Fort Ransom State Park and will transport you back in time. Sodbuster Days is an event unlike any other with events including a parade, horse-powered threshing, haying demo, interdenominational church service, and wheelwright demos. Enjoy live old-time music. Food and beverages will be available for purchase during the event.

Dakota Suns Garden & Winery Carrington, ND

Indulge in the delightful offerings of Dakota Suns Garden & Winery, where you can sip on wines crafted right on the premises or partake in a leisurely afternoon tasting. Their selection, available for purchase locally, boasts flavors derived from locally and regionally sourced fruits. Arrange for tastings for gatherings, small groups, or intimate occasions with prior reservations. Plus, this winery doubles as an garden wedding venue!

Cottonwood Cider House Ayr, ND

ND's first Cidery, Cottonwood Cider House crafts its cider from apples grown by Cottonwood Farm. Located by Ayr, ND, Cottonwood Farm is a fourth generation family-owned farm and ND's largest commercial organic mixed fruit orchard. Apple trees grow alongside alfalfa, native prairie flowers and grasses, dandelions, bees, and birds.

Nome Schoolhouse Nome, ND

Originally built in 1916, the Nome Schoolhouse was purchased by Teresa and Chris of Shepherd Industries, LLC and underwent a 3 year restoration bringing this historic building back to life. The restoration brought back many beautiful and historic features including windows, flooring, a large gymnasium, school rooms (which are now 11 bedrooms), and more on top of the new additions made to the building. The schoolhouse is now used as a Fiber Arts Retreat Center, event center, and boutique hotel. The schoolhouse puts on their own events and activities, and it can also be rented for weddings or other larger gatherings. There are rooms available to stay in inside the schoolhouse, and campsites on the property allow for this space to be multi-functional.
